

NORTHERN BAY COLLEGE

SCHOLARSHIP POLICY NBC064

1. PURPOSE:

- 1.1. Awarding scholarships to students can facilitate student achievement by ensuring continuation of studies at Northern Bay College for the recipient student.
- 1.2. Scholarships promote a culture of excellence and aspiration.
- 1.3. Scholarships are used to attract high achieving students to boost academic, sporting, artistic, cultural, and leadership qualities within the college.

2. BROAD GUIDELINES:

- 2.1. Scholarships will be offered across Northern Bay College at years six for academic excellence and year nine for academic, leadership and specific talent targets.
- 2.2. Eight Year 7-9 academic scholarships will be awarded each year to students in Year 6 with a maximum of two successful external applicants.
- 2.3. Eight Year 10-12 vocational scholarships will be awarded each year to students in Year 9.
- 2.4. School funded scholarships will be paid to the recipient directly into the families school account to ensure full participation in pursuit of achievement goals is not prevented through financial hardship.
- 2.5. Scholarships will be awarded through an open application and selection process, reference to previous results and achievement evidence.
- 2.6. Each scholarship will be for a three year period and will cover:
 - 2.6.1. Any school charges for the next three years
 - 2.6.2. All camps and excursions including Heroes Journey
 - 2.6.3. A college Blazer
 - 2.6.4. An iPad Air for year 7-9 and an Acer Notebook for years 10-12
- 2.7. Scholarships may also be funded by other organisations that may require criteria and conditions beyond Northern Bay College control.
- 2.8. Targetted scholarships either by direct sponsorship or College funded targetting specific groups, gender, cultural background must not compromise the College Core Values.

3. IMPLEMENTATION:

- 3.1. College Improvement Team will identify possible Scholarships to be offered for the college for the following year, by end of February for recommendation to Leadership for endorsement / modification.
- 3.2. The proposal and costings will be presented as a Budget request in October ready for School Council decision making.
- 3.3. College Leadership will present to School Council at the March meeting a proposal for Scholarships to be offered for the following year including criteria.
- 3.4. A selection process is will be undertaken for scholarships by a selection panel appointed by the College Principal.
- 3.5. All publicity is to be communicated with the College Liaison Officer for internal and external publications by the persons responsible.

4. EVALUATION:

- 4.1. This policy will be reviewed regularly as part of the school's three-year review cycle.
